A National Level webinar was organized by the commerce department on 24th June, 2020

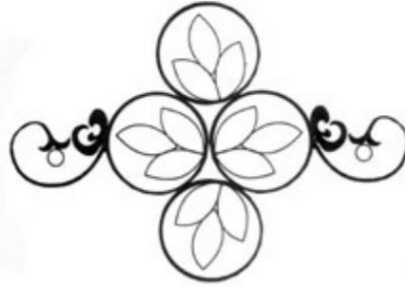

1. INTRODUCTION

Good Teacher
Excellent Teacher
Effective Teacher

I wish to drop all the above adjectives to a Teacher since Teacher is the one who has all these good adjectives as an attitude. Teaching profession is a divine profession, wherein a teacher is paid salary for learning themselves, as it helps building a nation with all kinds of advantages like facility, sophistication, safety, security etc. In this article I limit myself to a classroom teaching.

Once a question is posted to Ms. Angela Merkel, Former Chancellor of Germany by her administrators, ‘Why Teachers are paid highest salary? Her answer is, “Because they developed us to this level and expect nothing from us”.

We in India placed the Teacher (Guru), next to our parents but before The God, Madha (Mother), Pidha (Father), Guru (Teacher) and Theivam (God). This is because of the reason that next to parents, teacher is the one who wants to uplift students to a highest level of achievement and also being proud of it.

It is very common in our culture that “Aynthil Valayadhathu Aymbathil Valayadhu” which means young minds in students learn very many things as easy as possible. It is because of this process that a child can absorb the characters of Parents and Teachers. In this process Teachers play a vital role as most of us witnessed and is most common in every home that “Our teacher is correct, but you are not correct”. It is because the teachers inspire the young minds more than anyone. While study, a student comes across a number of teachers who have made positive impact, no impact and negative impact. Since the students will become the pillars of modern world the teachers who made positive impact in the young minds of the students is a treasure to a Nation. So, Teachers should be a role model to the students in the field of Education.

One who follows certain values, mentioned below, only can become a role model to the young minds, i.e., A TEACHER, who attributes the following qualities or values,

- Be Punctual
- Neat Dress Code

- Strong Communicator
- Show Empathy
- Have Patience
- Best Motivator

will only a TEACHER and can insist the same to the students.

2. Effective Teaching in a Period

In this part, I wish to convey a message as how a person can become a teacher by elaborating the values to be acquired by a teacher.

2.1. Be Punctual

Punctuality is an attitude everyone should have, can be inculcated in the young minds of the students by a teacher by coming to the class in time not even on time. In general, a person who starts doing his work in time always has a relaxed mind. With the relaxed mind one can think positively and can complete too many projects in a short time.

As we know,

If we lose wealth - Nothing is lost

If we lose health - Something is lost

If we lose character - Everything is lost

A person can build his character by being punctual.

A teacher who enters and leaves the class with utmost punctuality can attract the

students easily and will be loved by all the students. Such a teacher can only inculcate the attitude of punctuality in the minds of the students.

2.2. Neat Dress Code

A teacher who comes neatly dressed in all sense (Dress, Hair, Fresh face etc.) to the class in time could bring freshness in the minds of the students in the class. The fresh mind can easily absorb the matter passed on to the students and also allow them to understand the same. It is because the students get energized in seeing such a teacher and they like that teacher as we know a famous phrase “Aall Pathi Aadai Pathi”.

2.3. Highly Resourceful

A teacher should be a lifelong learner of new things to be imparted to the students. As we know from the famous quote of our divine Tamil poet Avvaiyar “Kattradhu Kai Munn Alavu” (what we learned so far is only a hand full but what we have to learn in world is enormous). A teacher should be a senior most student in a classroom. A teacher should have thorough knowledge in their subject, go to the class with just a few chalks and a duster and handle the class for even two to three hours, using the black board continuously and explaining the concepts very effectively. They are highly resourceful teachers. Every student love and wants to be like those teachers and never forget them in their life.

2.4. Best Planning and Execution

A teacher should have a plan of taking effective class right from entering into the class and till the end of the class. To make the class very effective, a teacher should have number of segments in the given time period and should not make use of the hundred percent of the class time to teach lesson. Here I consider the period duration is one hour and chalk and black board class.

In the first five minutes, teacher should get the attention of all the students in the classroom. This can be either cracking a joke, asking the students to do a gentle breathing or physical exercise, telling a short story, informing them a very important current event or general knowledge concept etc., etc.

In the next five minutes, teacher should have to recollect the lesson taught in the last class and its connection to the lesson of the present class. This process gives deep insight into the topic and makes the students to correlate the relation between various topics of the chapter.

In the next five minutes, teacher should have to give introduction to the current topic, its principle, importance and real time applications. By doing this, students would develop interest in this topic.

In the next forty minutes, teacher should teach the lesson by going to the level of the students. At the outset of this session, teacher can mention the main topic and the sub-topics to be discussed today to

the student on one side of the black board. The black board can be divided in to two to three segments depending upon the size of the black board which helps to use the black board very effectively. This session must be filled with suitable examples, analytical results, correlation with the other topic and illustrations like graph, diagram etc., with proper explanation. If it is a derivation or mathematics class necessary formula must be given as foot note for proper understanding. While doing so, a teacher should ask the students to listen to it and then give ample time to copy the material on the black board as well as provide ample opportunity to ask questions to get clarify their doubts. Though this is a slow process it is very effective to make the students observe and analyze the topic into a micro level. During this forty minutes, teacher should focus on the topic.

In the last five minutes, teacher should consolidate the topic covered on that day and allow the students to raise questions. This last five minutes is the culmination of a period wherein students can actively participate in the question answer session. The teacher should try to answer the questions asked by the students with correct and clear answers. Always encourage the students to raise questions and never underestimate the question. Because doubt of a student may be a small one for a teacher but it is a Himalayan big for that student. If exact answer for any of the question is not known, teacher can accept honestly about his/her ignorance and assure the students that it will be answered later. The teacher then should

find the answer and clarify the students with correct answer. This kind of behavior will fetch good name to a teacher among the students instead of giving incorrect answer or blurting/babbling on the day itself.

Later, teacher should wipe off the black board by himself/herself by following the top to bottom pattern and get ready for leaving the classroom with utmost punctuality.

2.5. Strong Communicator

For any teacher communication is a tool to make the students to overcome the fear over the subject but making them to enjoy the subject. A teacher with strong communication skill can effectively reach the minds of the students. In order to do this a teacher can adopt any of the skills like showing visual animations related to the subject, singing, telling stories and relating them to the subject, conducting some quiz programs, asking the students to deliver seminar or submitting the assignments etc. In other words, a teacher with strong communication is the one who engages the students by thinking outside the box, add humour to their lessons and finds creative ways to bring learning into the real world and strong classroom presence. Here it is essential to mention a very beautiful saying that,

If you learn you may forget

If you see you may remember

If you do you can understand

So, it is the duty of a teacher to give hand on experience to the students to make them understand the topic.

A teacher with thorough knowledge and being a strong communicator is the one who always makes eye to eye contact with all the students in the classroom throughout the period.

2.6. Show Empathy

One more key for improving the learning of a student is to treat each student as an individual, by being empathetic and understanding to what may be going on in their lives. Empathy and understanding a student by a teacher not only help that teacher to make a connection with a student, but it can also create an impact on student's learning in the classroom. By having such a divine connection with each student, a teacher can understand that something may be easy for one student may not be so easy for someone else. Everyone learns differently, whether it be faster or slower than normal, learns better by writing, reading or hands-on. Teachers need always to keep this in mind and always pay close attention to ensure whether each student is on the track they need to be. A best commander is the one who knows that "pace of the fleet is not the speed of the first ship but the last ship". Similarly, a successful teacher is the one who makes the slow learner to reach the pace of the quick learner.

2.7. Have Patience

One of the prime attitudes that every teacher should acquire is patience. By having patience, teacher can solve very many issues successfully. Patience is one of the most important skills to be practiced by a teacher, while managing classroom behaviour or communicating student issues or progress with parents. More often you have to have more patience with the parents than you do with the students. As parents are coming in with their perceptions of what happened to them when they were students or previous experiences that may have been detrimental to their child. You must be patient in understanding them.

A successful teacher is the one who always has two things on their lips, a smile to solve the problems and silence to avoid problems.

2.8. Best Motivator

Motivation is a magic word which can do wonders and make the students to reach the “cloud nine” by tasting success in their lives. Teacher should always motivate the students to set a big goal and to attain the same through number of small successes. Tamil divine poet Thiruvalluvar says in one of his Kural that “one has aim for the catching of an elephant instead of catching a rabbit”. Teacher should constantly inform the students that they have to equip themselves with all sorts of skills, acquiring knowledge and acquiring higher qualification in the younger age itself. Teacher do not hesitate to praise the students in the class even for a

small achievement. But at each should not punish the students in front of the others.

2.9. Great Lover of the Institution

Teacher should be a great lover of his/her institution and tries to grow along with the growth of the institution.

3. CONCLUSION

“Inspire your students with your intelligence, brilliance, sincerity, perseverance, affection, interest, involvement, hard working and other optimistic characters. Teacher should always think that they are “Nation Builders”.”

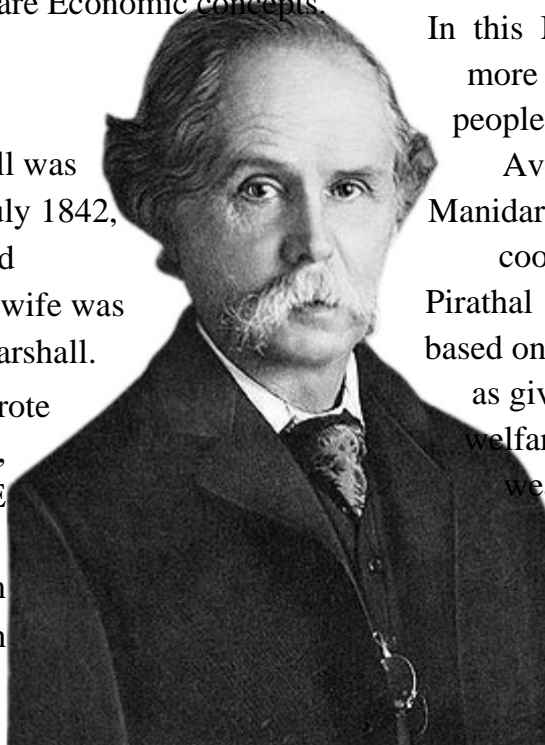

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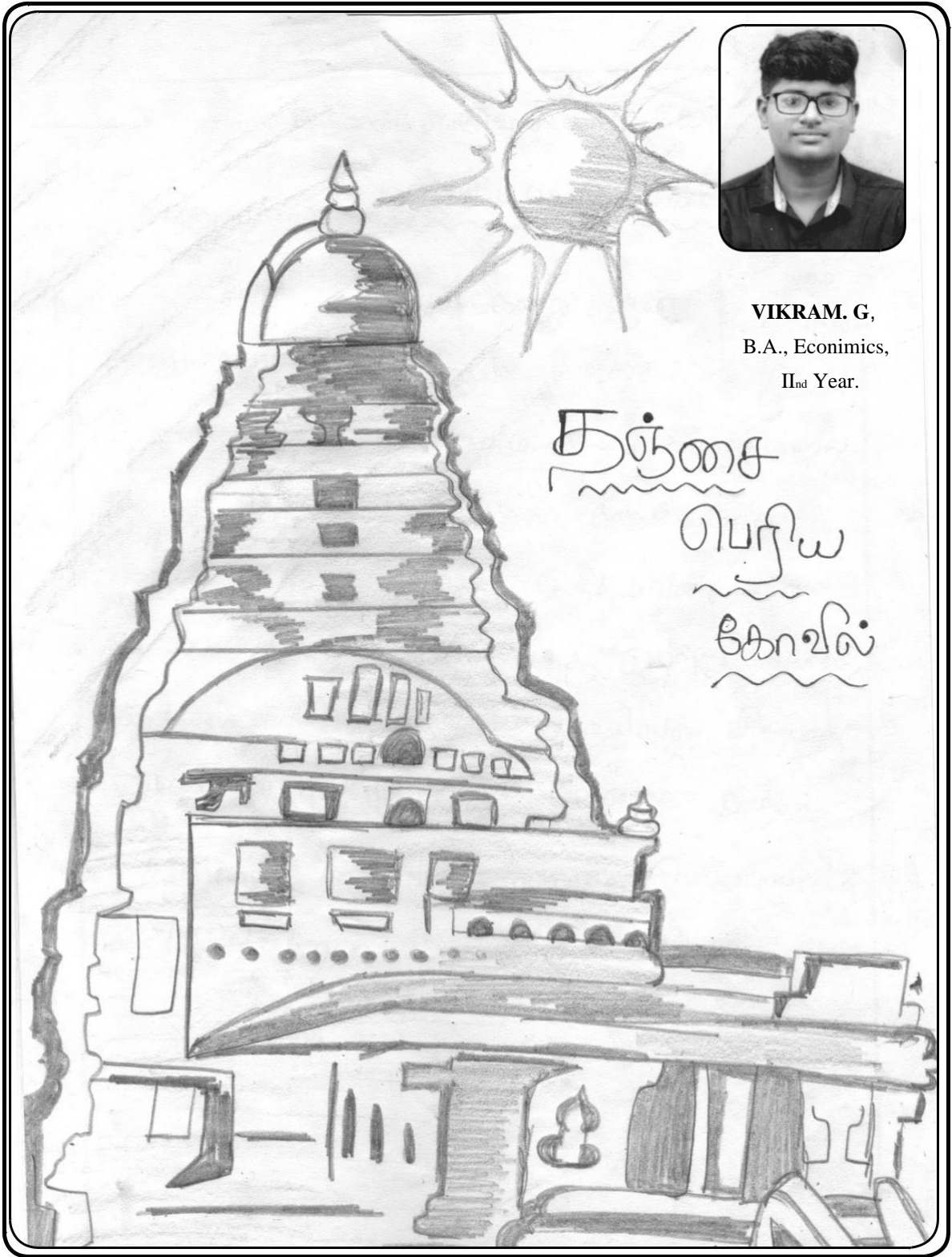

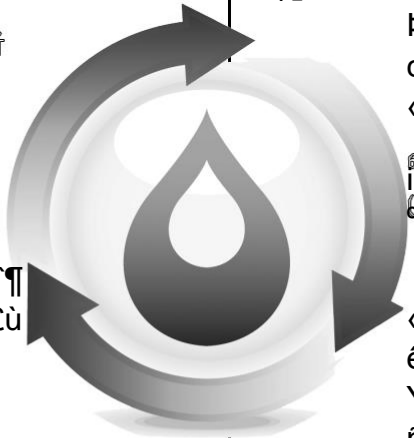
