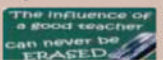

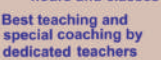

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

- Admission of students in various courses in Shift-I / Shift-II during the academic year 2019-2020 shall be filled up by only on adhering reservations as per the Government norms.
- Candidates for admission to the first year of the Degree of Bachelor of Arts & Science courses shall be required to have passed the Higher Secondary Examinations conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu or an examination accepted as equivalent thereof by the Syndicate of the University of Madras, provided that the candidates for admission into the specific main subject of study shall possess such other qualifying conditions as may be prescribed by the University.
- Applications for admission and prospectus can be obtained from the college office on payment of Rs. 50/- for Shift-I and Rs.150/- for Shift-II. Application is to be duly filled in and returned to the college office on or before the last date announced by the College. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
The last day for registering the application is 10 days after the date of publication of the results of the Higher Secondary Examinations.
- Students selected for admission should pay the fee in one instalment and submit their Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate and Higher Secondary School Examination Certificate, Medical Certificate and Community Certificate.
The students are advised to keep with them sufficient number of attested copies as the originals submitted to the college will not be returned in the middle of the course of study. Students selected for admission should produce the following certificates in original

- Selected candidates will have to pay the tuition fee and other fee immediately after the interview. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. Request for extension of time for payment of fee will not be entertained. Selected candidate should come with their parent at the time of admission without fail.
- Students who have passed the qualifying examinations from other states will be admitted on production of the required eligibility certificates from the Registrar, University of Madras.
- Admission fee of Rs. 5/- has to be paid along with the tuition fee, special fee etc., at the time of admission.
- Students who are provisionally selected for counseling will be intimated by SMS and they must appear before the Principal on the date specified.**
- Receipt of waiting list call letter by students, do not assure admission, since more number of waiting list call letters are generally sent for less number of vacancies for which selection is strictly made on merit basis.
- All admissions are subject to verification of mark certificates by the Director of Government Examinations and if the mark certificate is found to be bogus, admissions are liable for cancellation besides contemplating criminal action against the candidate.
- A candidate applying for more than one course has to submit separate application form for each course.
- Application form issued to a candidate is not transferable. The filled-in application may either be dropped in the receipt box kept in the college or sent by post addressed to "THE PRINCIPAL, C. KANDASWAMI NAIDU COLLEGE, ANNA NAGAR EAST, CHENNAI - 600 102."

- Students belonging to SC/ST will be given application at FREE of Cost for Shift-I by producing photocopy of community certificate.
